## Please observe the following policies:

- All bicycles (including e-bikes) are allowed on the bike lanes on all roads in the park. Colorado State Motor Vehicle rules pertaining to bicycles apply.
- Control your speed. Prevent accidents by riding cautiously. **The Park-wide speed limit of 20 mph applies to bicycles as well.**
- Use only designated trails when riding or walking your bike.
  - Traditional bikes are permitted on trails in the shaded light blue area.
  - Traditional bicycles and Class 1 e-bikes are allowed on the Foothills Trail, Gateway Trail, and the Palmer Mesa trail to the north.
  - **E-bikes are not allowed on any dirt trails.**
- Always yield to hikers, horses and uphill traffic. Let others know of your presence well in advance. Dismount and move to the side when a horse is approaching
- Leave No Trace. No shortcuts or cross-country riding. Avoid riding on muddy trails.
- Be alert for wildlife. Give them a chance to move away from the trail. It's their park, too!



## E-Bike Class Definitions

- **Class 1:** An e-bike equipped with pedal-assist only, with motor support that stops once the bike reaches 20 mph.
- **Class 2:** An e-bike with a throttle that can propel the bike without pedaling, but the motor assistance stops at 20 mph.
- **Class 3:** A pedal-assist-only e-bike with motor support up to 28 mph and typically equipped with a speedometer.
